Proposed changes to the School's Responsible Behaviour Plan

Officers at the Department's Moreton Regional Office have recently reviewed Glenala State High School's Responsible Behaviour Plan and have proposed that changes be made to the Responsible Behaviour Plan, particularly in the areas of discrimination and harassment based on impairment, disability and race.

Because Moreton Regional Office has proposed changes to the School's Responsible Behaviour Plan, the School will conduct its own review of the Responsible Behaviour Plan. In order to comply with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, consultation with parents, staff and students will occur as part of the review process. It is expected that this consultation will occur when school has resumed in 2009. Parents, staff and students are encouraged to participate.
