## 2017 Goals

- 90% A – C level of achievement
- 100% positive relative gain in NAPLAN
- Increase in U2B
- School opinion survey >95% parent, student and staff satisfaction

## 2017 Successful Strategies

- Continued to embed the Positive Behaviour for Learning framework. This work linked with ASOT and other evidenced based research to explore with staff - student cognitive, emotional and behavioural engagement.
- Continued to employ culturally appropriate staff across the school to ensure parent, student and community engagement.
- Reduced class size across junior secondary to better support and provide interventions for EALD, below NMS and potential U2B students.
- Literacy was a whole school priority – concentrating particularly on Reading.
- Continued Quicksmart literacy and numeracy intervention program for identified Year 7 and 8 students
- Continued a thorough NAPLAN preparation program for Junior Secondary through curriculum and Numlit.

## 2017 Snapshot of Successes

- 100% QCE for 2017 Year 12 students
- Academic achievement measured by level of achievement A- C 95%
- School Opinion Survey: 'This is a good school' 99.0% of teachers; 'My child likes being at this school' 97.2% of parents; 'My school celebrates student achievements' 96.7% of students agree.
- Notable positive relative gain: Year 7 93.7% Reading; 97.3% Spelling; 93.8% Numeracy; Year 9 94.1% Numeracy
